One Night at The Museum

On 31st October 2017, 20 members of the BMSACO visited the 1st Central County Ground Museum for a guided tour by Jon Filby. Jon is the Curator of the Museum and is also Sussex Cricket Foundation Chairman.

Jon began by giving an overall picture of the development of the museum. Many members can remember the museum as the former groundsmen store and umpires

room. Now the area has been transformed into a compact and well organised museum.

The 1 ½ hour tour commenced looking back at the Australians visit around 1878, the career of CB Fry and James Horace Parks and observing the war memorial to Sussex Cricket. It is claimed that Sussex is the oldest Club in the world. The tour continued to look at the careers of James Lillywhite who was the first captain of England, Ted Dexter, Ranjitsinghe, up to and including cricketers past and present and an interactive section where you can find out more about the present players at the Club.

At the conclusion of the visit, our Chairman, Trevor Burchell, thanked Jon for the tour and the members thanked Jon in the usual way.

Following the museum tour, the members enjoyed a fish and chip supper followed by a session on 'How did we manage?' where there were some very lively discussions on the following topics:

- the 2017 Laws of Cricket and its implementation,
- weather interruptions during the season and overs calculation,
- Umpires and Captains discussion at the coin toss,
- wide ball deliveries in overs matches,
- Disciplinary issues at a number of matches
